

## Words With ch and tch

- The **digraph ch** stands for the sound you hear at the beginning of the word **chase** and at the end of the word **crunch**.
- The letters **-tch** stand for the sound you hear at the end of the word **match**. The **-tch** spelling is used at the end of a word or syllable.
